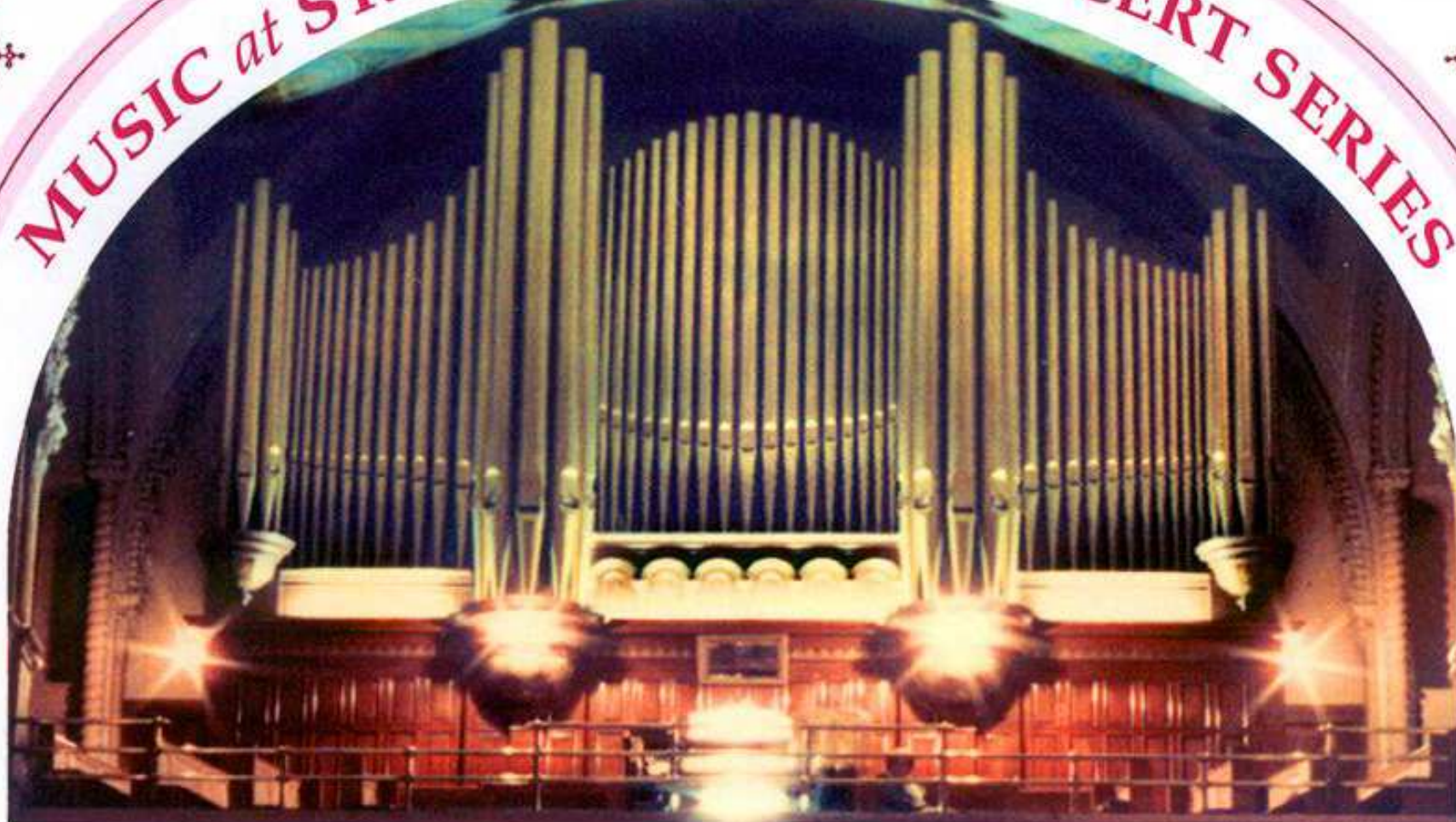

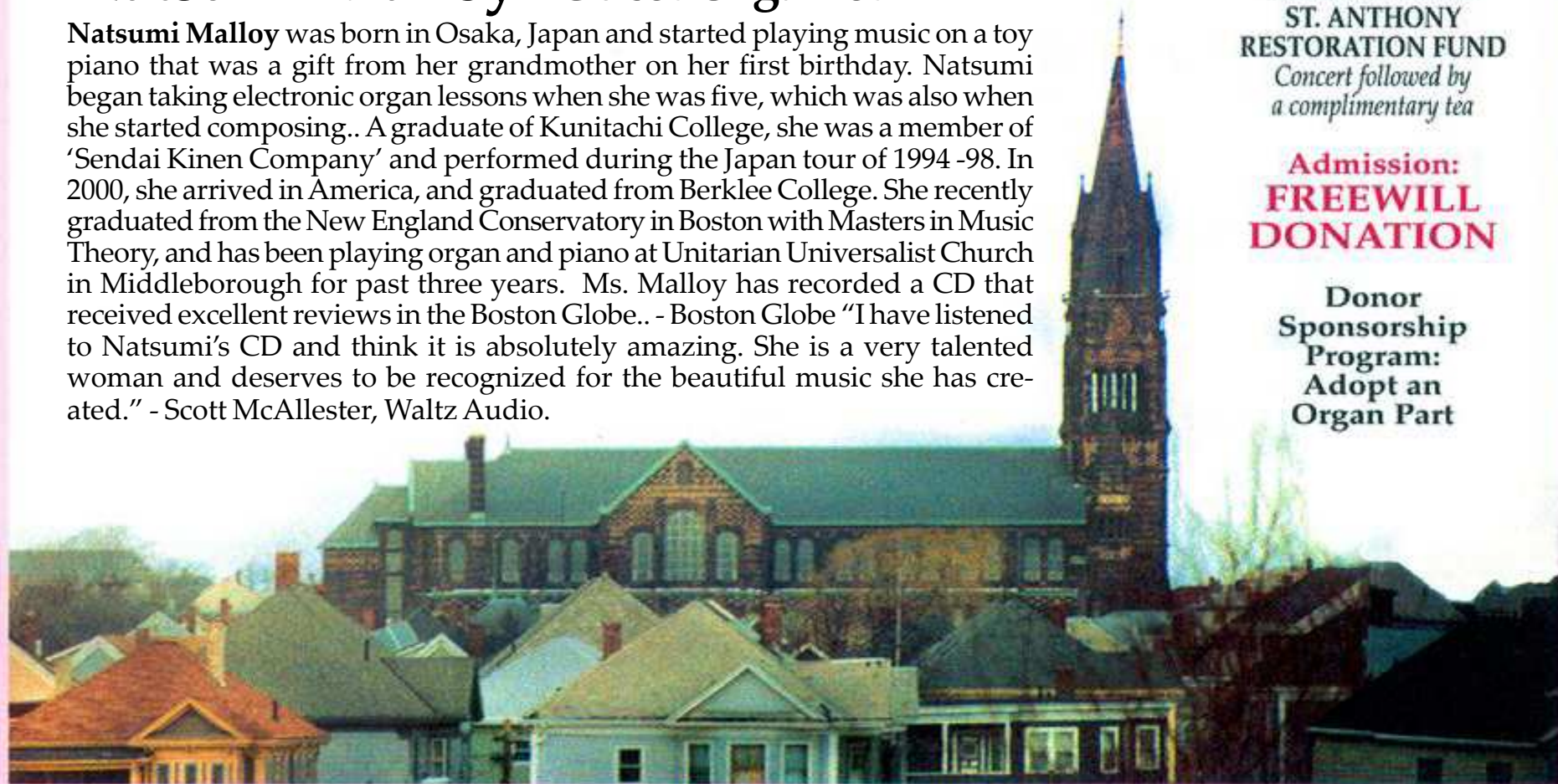
Natsumi Malloy - Guest Organist

Natsumi Malloy was born in Osaka, Japan and started playing music on a toy piano that was a gift from her grandmother on her first birthday. Natsumi began taking electronic organ lessons when she was five, which was also when she started composing. A graduate of Kunitachi College, she was a member of 'Sendai Kinen Company' and performed during the Japan tour of 1994 -98. In 2000, she arrived in America, and graduated from Berklee College. She recently graduated from the New England Conservatory in Boston with Masters in Music Theory, and has been playing organ and piano at Unitarian Universalist Church in Middleborough for past three years.
